Summer Concerts and Events: We extend routes #3, #8 and add park & ride service for all summer concerts on Fanny Hill. Service starts 30 minutes before and ends 1 hour after end of event. Service covering other winter routes may be added.

Bicycles on Shuttles: The shuttle buses will carry as many bikes as there is room on the bike racks (up to 4 on the shuttle.)

Bike service is on a first come first served basis. No bikes are allowed inside shuttles.

Dogs: Dogs are welcome on shuttles at the discretion of the driver and must be on a leash. Please keep pets off the shuttle seats.
